CIRCULAR

In order to protect the CHSS beneficiaries from acquiring/spreading H1N1 infection, it has been decided to administer the H1N1 preventive vaccine to the beneficiaries under CHSS in terms of DOS OM No.11015/1/2015-V dated 04th March, 2015 (copy enclosed).

Accordingly, all the Area Medical Officers/Medical Officers located/identified under CHS Scheme in Bangalore are hereby advised through this Circular to give prescriptions to the CHSS beneficiaries staying in Bangalore to enable them to approach the nearest Government Hospital/CHSS recognized hospitals to get immunized with the Swine Flu (H1N1) vaccine.

Employees covered under the conditions stipulated in the said DOS OM dated 04.03.2015 are hereby advised to approach the concerned Area Medical Officers/Medical Officers with valid CHSS cards for self and dependent family members (those who are fulfilling the conditions stipulated in the DOS OM dated 04.03.2015) to obtain the prescriptions for Swine Flu (H1N1) vaccine and get immunized in the hospitals recognized under CHSS and seek reimbursement from the respective offices.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Contributory Health Service Scheme (CHSS) - H1N1 preventive vaccine
- Admissibility - regarding.

The undersigned is directed to state that some Centres/Units have sought clarification from the Department for administering H1N1 Preventive Vaccine to beneficiaries under CHSS including those who are residing in DOS/ISRO residential colonies.

2. The matter was examined in the Department. It has been decided to allow vaccination to be done in Government Hospitals/CHSS empanelled Hospitals in the respective cities, only for the following high risk Groups in ISRO/DOS Presently:

- i) Pregnant women and infant caregivers.
- ii) Healthcare and emergency medical services personnel
- iii) Everyone between ages 6 months and 24 years
- iv) Those between ages 25 and 64 with health issues such as Bronchitis asthma, COPD, chronic bronchitis, Diabetes etc.

3. The periodicity of H1N1 vaccination will be one year and the vaccine charges may be borne by the concerned Centre/Unit.

4. In addition to the above hospitals, procurement of vaccines by Centres from other than Government agencies, if necessary, may be done after following due Purchase Procedures (Quotations/Rebates etc.).

5. DOS/ISRO Centres/Units may take a suitable decision, depending upon the situation that warrants.

6. This OM will be effective from the date of its issue. Hindi version will follow.
